Girl Teen Time (GTT) is a group for incoming 7th and 8th grade girls. It is designed to foster self-esteem, help girls maintain authentic connection with peers and adult women in their community, counter trends toward self-doubt, and allow for genuine self-expression through verbal sharing and creative activities. Each week a group of 8-12 girls take turns talking, listening and expressing themselves further through creative or focused activities such as journaling, movement, art and so on. Oftentimes, themes are introduced which relate to the girls' lives – such as being a girl, trusting ourselves, friendships, body image, goals, competition and decision making.

Girl Teen Time (GTT) seeks to encourage the development of strength, courage, confidence, honesty and communication skills for girls. Our goal is to enhance girls' abilities so they are able to take full advantage of their talents, academic interests, and potential for healthy relationships.
